A Brief Focus

A group of international scientists from the USA and EU has released a peer-reviewed pilot study that suggests the anogenital distance of baby girls is becoming more male-typical, due to their mothers being exposed to glyphosate when they are in the womb. The preliminary findings suggest that glyphosate is an endocrine disruptor with androgenic effects in humans.

Given the increasing glyphosate exposure worldwide (glyphosate use has increased 15-fold since genetically modified – GMO - crops were introduced in 1996), large studies should evaluate glyphosate's developmental effects on endocrine systems.*
