

Montmorillonite, which is a functional ingredient in Harrison's Bird Foods, is a specific type of clay mineral. Bentonite is a broader term referring to a group of clay minerals, including montmorillonite.

Montmorillonite may have anti-inflammatory, anti-diarrheal, and protective effects for the digestive tract.

All Harrison's Bird Foods formulas are tested multiple times during production for toxins, such as lead or arsenic.

Many packaged baked goods are made with flour that may contain potassium bromate, an additive linked to cancer. The chemical is added to flour to strengthen dough and allow it to rise higher, benefits that have led many U.S. companies to embrace it. Potassium bromate is banned in several countries, including Brazil, Canada, the European Union and the United



Kingdom. Despite health concerns, potassium bromate is legal for use in the US (although California requires food with potassium



bromate to carry a warning label), and the FDA hasn't reviewed it since at least 1973.
